Measure ID	Measure Name	Measure Description
AHAR-1	ECG within 10 minutes of arrival	Percentage of ST-elevation Myocardial Infarction patients who received an ECG within 10 minutes of arrival
AHAR-2	Arrival or Subsequent STEMI-Positive ECG to Thrombolytics within 30 minutes	Percentage of all ST-elevation Myocardial Infarction (STEMI) patients who receive thrombolytic therapy within 30 minutes of arrival. For patients with STEMI first diagnosed on subsequent ECG: Percentage of patients who receive thrombolytic therapy within 30 minutes of subsequent ECG time.
AHAR-3	Arrival or Subsequent STEMI-Positive ECG to Transfer to PCI Center within 45 minutes (Door in door out)	Percentage of ST-elevation Myocardial Infarction (STEMI) patients who are transferred out for primary PCI within 45 minutes of arrival. For patients with STEMI first diagnosed on subsequent ECG: Percentage of patients who are transferred out for primary PCI within 45 minutes of subsequent ECG time.
AHAR-4	EMS FMC to PCI \leq 90 minutes (when applicable) ¹	Percentage of STEMI patients who receive primary PCI within 90 minutes from EMS First Medical Contact.

¹ When applicable if the AHAR provides any PCI coverage for primary PCI.
